CAPRIFOLIACEAE – HONEYSUCKLE FAMILY

Smooth Arrowwood – *Viburnum dentatum*

LOBELIACEAE – LOBELIA FAMILY

Downy Lobelia – *Lobelia puberula*

ASTERACEAE (COMPOSITAE) – ASTER FAMILY

Philadelphia Fleabane – *Erigeron philadelphicus*

Daisy Fleabane – *Erigeron annuus* (road)

Daisy Fleabane – *Erigeron strigosus* (road)

Black-eyed Susan – *Rudbeckia hirta*

Yarrow – *Achillea millefolium*

Ox-eye Daisy – *Leucanthemum vulgare* (*Chrysanthemum leucanthemum*)
